• Public Education and Outreach

The Town website received "hits" during 2009. The Town plans to add additional stormwater web links to its website during 2010. Web links may include Northeast Wisconsin Stormwater Consortium (www.newwaterwisconsin.org), Wisconsin Department of Natural Resouces (DNR), UW-Extension and US EPA.
A display rack with educational material is located in the foyer of the Town Hall. Educational materials regarding illicit discharges, household hazardous waste disposal, composting benefits, shoreline management, rain gardens, and construction site erosion controls are provided in the display racks. Approximately stormwater related educational materials were taken from the display racks during 2009.
The Town actively distributed pet waste brochures to individuals that applied for pet licenses during 2009.
Every four months, the Town actively distributes or mails its quarterly newsletter to homeowners and businesses. During 2009, the newsletter contained information about illicit discharges, household hazardous waste disposal, recycling collection, garbage collection, composting benefits, shoreline management, rain gardens, and construction site erosion controls. The Town intends to continue adding stormwater articles and educational information to its newsletters during 2010.
"Permit Certificates" were posted at 15 construction sites during 2009. The "Permit Certificate" educated the public about construction site erosion control and provided a phone number for the public to ask questions and/or provide tips.
Stormwater topics were discussed at public meetings during 2009. The Town educated the public on various stormwater topics including the MS4 Annual Report and
The Town maintained its membership with NEWSC during 2009. NEWSC continues to develop educational materials and mass media materials for its members. Please refer to the 2009 NEWSC Annual Permit Report already on file with the DNR.
Public Involvement and Participation
The Town discussed stormwater during public meetings during 2009. The public was provided an opportunity to become involved and participate during the public meetings. Various stormwater topics were discussed including but not limited to the MS4 Annual Report and

SECTION IX. Department of Commerce Authority
Section 2.4.1.1.3 of the MS4 general permit requires a permittee that does not already have authority from the Wisconsin Department of Commerce (Commerce) to regulate erosion control at public buildings and places of employment to request such authority from Commerce within 18 months after the start date of permit coverage. However, as of January 1, 2010, responsibility for erosion control administration and enforcement for commercial building sites was transferred from Commerce to the Department of Natural Resources. This transfer took place due to 2009 Wisconsin Act 28, the 2009 state budget legislation, which moved s. 101.1205, Wis. Stats., commercial building construction site soil erosion and sediment control statutory language, to s. 281.33, Wis. Stats. As of January 1, 2010, the Statecs requirements for erosion control at commercial building construction sites will be administered by the Department of Natural Resources. Accordingly, a permitted municipality that was delegated to serve as an agent for Commerce will continue to serve as an agent for the Department of Natural Resources in accordance with the original agreement with Commerce unless this delegation is revoked by the Department of
