 - Public Education and Outreach

The Town recently created a website. The Town plans to add additional stormwater web links to its website during 2012. Web links may include Winnebago County Land & Water Conservation Department, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resouces (DNR), UW-Extension and US EPA.

A display rack with educational material is located in the foyer of the Town Hall. Educational materials regarding illicit disharges, lawn fertilizers, soil testing, weeds & pesticides, lawn watering, grass clippings, leaf maintenance, pet waste, household hazardous waste and car care are provided in the display rack.

Every six months, the Town actively distributes or mails its semi-annual newsletter to approximately 700 homeowners and businesses. During 2011, the newsletter contained information about household hazardous waste disposal, recycling collection, garbage collection, and good household practices. The Town intends to continue adding stormwater articles and educational information to its newsletter in 2012. Potential stormwater topics include lawn fertilizers, residential infiltration, leaves, grass clippings, stream and shoreline erosion, illicit discharges, construction site erosion control, post-construction stormwater management, household practices, household hazardous wasate and/or car care.

"Permit Certificates" were posted at 17 construction sites during 2011. The "Permit Certificate" educated the public about construction site erosion control and provided a phone number for the public to ask questons and/or provide tips.

Stormwater topics were discussed at 6 public meetings during 2011.

Public Involvement and Participation

The public was provided an opportunity to become involved and participate during the meetings. Various stormwater topics were discussed, including but not limited to the MS4 Annual Report.

The public submitted stormwater tips and complaints to the Town and County 1 time during 2011.

The Town performed ongoing field screening of 2 outfalls during 2011.

No hazardous spills were investigated or reported during 2010.

No illicit discharge or spill notifications were issued to adjacent municipalities or DNR during 2011.

No "warning notices", "notices of violation" or enforcement actions were issued during 2011.

No illicit discharge tips or complaints were received from the general public during 2011.

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No education brochures were distributed during 2011.

The Winnebago County Ordinance is applicable to land-disturbing construction activity, new land development, and land redevelopment activity located within the boundaries and jurisdiction of the unincorporated portion of Winnebago County. Winnebago County is responsible for ordinance adoption, implementation, enforcement and education on behalf of the Town. Winnebago County provided the following 2011 information for construction site located within the Town of Neenah

7 construction site erosion control permits were issued during 2011 (2 one or two family residential, 2 fill, 1 road/access, 1 erosion control & 1 for town road swale maintenance), 17 sites were inspected (7 new sites and 10 ongoing sites from 2010), 34 total site inspections were performed, 17 permits were posted at construction sites, 1 erosion control tip / complaint was received from the general public, 0 written "warning notices" and 2 verbal "warning notices" were issued, 1 "notice of violation" was issued, and 0 fines were issued.

No plans or new permits were issued during 2011. However, there were 3 existing/ongoing stormwater management permits that were finalized during 2011. There were no new maintenance agreements recorded at the County Register of Deeds and 1 post-construction tip / complaint was received from the general public.
